#### Maths

Nursery - counting on and back, counting objects, matching 2D shapes, copying and matching patterns, language of 1 more, combining groups, comparing objects by size.

Reception -counting to 10/20, recognising & ordering numerals to 10, matching numerals to quantities, naming and describing 2D shape, continuing and creating repeating patterns, practical addition including number bonds to 5, practical subtraction.

Adapt to the new environments and routines of their year group. Select and use resources in self-chosen activities.
