Welcome back to the new term!

I hope that you have all had a happy and restful holiday; it seems that the children have come back refreshed and ready to work, so we are looking forward to seeing what they can achieve this year. We are very glad to welcome our secretary Mrs Thompson back after her sick leave. She will be back to working in the office on Mondays, Tuesday and Thursday, so if possible can you keep all queries about uniform and payments till then. We are also pleased to welcome back Mrs Nicola Clark, who covered for Mrs Bowyer when she was ill last term; Mrs Bowyer is going to be working mornings only from now on, and Mrs Clark will be working with Early Years on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. We will also have a member of the Music Service doing a singing lesson with Reception and Class 1 on a Friday afternoon while Miss Morgan does Recorder lessons with Class 2.

PE and other equipment

We will be having PE lessons on **Tuesday** and **Thursday** afternoons for Classes 1 & 2, and **Wednesday** afternoon for Early Years. Please can you make sure that the children have their PE kit in school on those days. They will need trainers to wear in the playground or on the field, and if we have PE in the Hall they will need Plimsolls or they can have bare feet.

Please can you make sure that children **ALWAYS** have their Wellies in school, so that they are able to access all the playground areas at playtime. This is particularly important now that the Autumn weather is coming and the grounds will be more muddy, and also because we have more children coming in we need to use all the space available.

Please can you make children **ALWAYS** have their reading books in school. This is so that the teacher or a volunteer can hear them read whenever there is a spare moment. We have volunteers in to hear children read on **Monday** and **Wednesday** in Class 1, and **Tuesday** in Class 2; if the books are not in school, it is not always easy to find time to change them at other times.
