New Morning Drop off procedures

We would like to try out a new procedure for morning drop off with the children from Reception to Class 2 in order to avoid high spirits and rough play before school starts and encourage independence and a calm purposeful start to the day. Children will be allowed to come in to school from 8.50 am, and school will start at 9.00 am. Breakfast Club will finish at 8.50 am, and those children will go directly to their classrooms where they will engage in quiet, independent activities until everybody has arrived. Linda will stand at the outside of the cloakroom corridor entrance to receive children from their parents and to ensure they come in sensibly, collect all the belongings that they need for the classroom and go straight in to their teacher. She will also take any messages that parents may need to pass on about home time or after school arrangements. If parents need to talk to staff about medication or other matters, please could they go to the office. There will be no children playing on the playground before school unless they are supervised as part of Breakfast Club. There will also be no adults supervising children on the playground, so please make sure that you hand your children over to Linda, so she knows that YOU know they have arrived safely. Children on School Transport will come in to school as soon as they arrive. Linda will lock the door at 9.00 am. Any children arriving after 9.00 will enter school through the front door.
