

Maths

Nursery - counting on and back, counting objects, matching 2D shapes, copying and matching patterns, language of 1 more, combining groups, comparing objects by size.

Reception - counting to 10/ 20, counting on within 10, recognising & ordering numerals to 10 and beyond, matching numerals to quantities, naming and describing 2D shape, continuing and creating repeating patterns, practical addition including number bonds to 5, practical subtraction.

Language and Communication

Listen to and join in with a wide variety of stories and rhymes and non-fiction texts (People who help theme). Respond to simple instructions. Talk freely and in a group about different occupations and how people help us/ how we can help others. Understand and respond to how and why questions. Listen to a variety of adults talking about their jobs and ask appropriate questions.

Literacy and Phonics

Stories around the theme of People Who Help, including medical professionals, firefighters, police officers. Stories where characters demonstrate helpful and friendly behaviours and work together as a team.

Nursery - general sound discrimination - environmental sounds (Letters and Sounds, Phase One, Aspect 1)

Reception - Learning the letters and sounds in sets 1 to 5 of Phase 2 Letters and Sounds. Reading and writing these sounds. Beginning to blend to read simple words containing these sounds, and segmenting to write them. Reading Phase 2 tricky words.

Early Years

People Who Help

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Adapt to the new environments and routines of their year group. Select and use resources in self-chosen activities. Show confidence in communicating about their own lives and experiences, including talking about their own helping behavior (how can we help our friends?). Be aware of their own needs and those of others. Take turns, share and show friendly behaviour. Develop an understanding of 'teamwork'.

Understanding The World

Show an interest in the lives of others and understand that different people do different jobs. Listen to adults talking about their jobs.

Understand that exercise, rest and healthy eating lead to good health, linking to learning about medical professionals (how they help us and how we can help ourselves).

Healthy Lifestyles Week

Learn about the emergency services and their role. Learn about emergency vehicles.

ICT -People Who Help games - Rainbow Street, Cbeebies (Get Well Soon, Postman Pat). Using the IWB and developing mouse skills on the PCs.

Expressive Art and Design

Self-portraits and portraits of our friends.

Design and create healthy foods (fruit kebabs, smoothies)

Physical Development

PE - Body movement and simple equipment skills. Nursery - begin to dress for PE with help as required. Reception to develop these skills and help Nursery children.

Gaining control over tools, including in structured creative activities (portraits). and food preparation activities (including making soup for the Harvest Lunch)
