Welcome back to the new school year. I hope you all enjoyed the holidays – it has been lovely hearing all about the adventures the children have had. Thank you to all the families who helped water the plants in the garden and greenhouse over the summer. Mr and Mrs Hilton have finished building the keyhole gardens now, and they are helping to make the grounds look much tidier. We are also delighted to have our new trampoline; thank you for the donations towards it, the children are really enjoying using it.

We are really pleased to welcome our new starters in Nursery, and we also have a new member of staff, Mrs Jane Armstrong, who is working as a teaching assistant in Early Years on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.

Breakfast club and Chat and Relax club

Breakfast club will run every morning from 8.00 am to 8.50. It is £3.00 per session, and includes a breakfast of cereal or toast. Chat and Relax runs from 4.30 - 6.00 pm on Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, and from 3.30 - 6.00 pm on Wednesday. It is charged at £2.50 per half hour. This will include a snack and quiet activities such as board games, art, craft or computer, or on a fine day the children might play outside in the school or Parish Hall playground. Linda will run both of these clubs and they are available for children from Reception to Year 4.
